The children come to the public library, listen to a story, get a tour of the building, receive a new book and are given their *first library card*.

The goal of the program has been to encourage parents of kindergarteners to obtain library cards for their children and to take their children to public libraries to borrow books and participate in children's programs.

This year, with the many changes in all the schools and their budgets, the challenge continues. We hope we can continue to support children on their journey into literacy.
