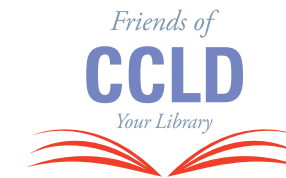

- 1. Eligible entrants: Students Grades 1-12.
- 2. One poem per entrant is allowed, inspired by images found at link listed above. Poem must be typed in simple font, preferably Times New Roman, 12pt.
- 3. Poem must be the original work of the entrant.
- 4. Previously entered poems are not eligible.
- 5. Entrants should type their full name, address, contact phone, e-mail, and the title of the image that inspired the poem in the bottom left corner of the last page of the poem.
